Regimental Combat Team 1 is a ground combat element in the Multi National Force-West ranks. It is comprised of several infantry and combat support units with the mission to secure, support and reconstruct the Anbar Province. As well as rid the region of any al Qaeda in Iraq members and transition security to the Iraqi Forces. The Marines, sailors and soldiers of RCT-1 perform a large spectrum of operations on a daily basis. Foot patrols walking the city streets, route clearing convoys searching for explosive devices, building schools, providing humanitarian aid, training Iraqi policeman and soldiers, building community relations, employing diplomacy among tribal leaders, and defending liberty. Every day, the service men and women of Regimental Combat Team 1 work tirelessly to give the Iraqi people a better tomorrow. There are a few hundred troops who work at headquarters element of RCT-1. The Marines, sailors and soldiers are spread across the Anbar Province from Fallujah to Ramadi, and everywhere else in between. Some items that can be very useful to the troops are various snack items such as beef jerky, crackers, pop-tarts, peanuts, trail mixes, breakfast and protein bars, vitamin drink mixes, and anything that can be in individual packages that are easy to pack and pick up on the go. Other essential items are toiletries - shampoos, body wash, soaps, shaving cream, toothpaste, razors, q-tips and tooth brushes.
